



## Mesa County Elections “I Voted” Sticker Contest Rules

- All entrants must be in grades 1-12 and enrolled in a Mesa County public school, charter school, private school, or home school program
- Three winners will be chosen: one elementary student (grades 1-5), one middle school student (grades 6-8), and one high school student (grades 9-12)
- Only one entry per student
- The phrase “I Voted” must be included in the design
- All entries must consist entirely of the student’s original, non-copyright artwork and may not include photos or trademarked images
- Artwork must be nonpartisan and not reference any candidate, political party, or political issue
- Artwork that contains offensive language, violence, drugs, gangs, weaponry, etc. will not be considered
- Entries may be hand drawn or digitally designed
  - Hand-drawn entries must use the attached template
  - Digital files must be under 1 GB and must be a .pdf, .png, .jpg, or .jpeg
- By entering the contest, the student is allowing Mesa County Elections to use, reproduce, edit, or publish in any medium or media, their submission in whole or in part, for any non-commercial purpose in perpetuity
- The attached release form must be signed by a parent/guardian and submitted with your artwork
- **All entries must be received by October 31, 2023**
